LEO S. ROWE FUND SUPPLEMENTARY SCHOLARSHIPS APPLICATION FORM

Thanks to a generous contribution from the U.S. Permanent Mission to the OAS during the Pan American Week celebrations, the Rowe Fund program will now provide non-refundable scholarships of \$2,000 each to eligible applicants who are simultaneously applying for a Rowe Fund interest-free loan. These scholarships aim to further support individuals in their educational pursuits and contribute to the development of the Latin American and Caribbean region.

The scholarships will be awarded based on several criteria, including financial need, scholastic achievement, and a strong desire to contribute to the progress of the Latin American and Caribbean Region. While the Rowe Fund supplementary scholarship is open to applicants from various fields of study, priority will be given to STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) and environmental science-related disciplines. However, please note that certain fields, including medicine, nursing, dentistry, aviation, MBA programs, and LLM are excluded from the scholarship eligibility.

Applications for the Rowe Fund, including the scholarship component, are evaluated throughout the year by the members of the Rowe Fund Committee. The Committee thoroughly reviews both the scholarship and interest-free loan applications to determine the most deserving candidates.
