IPC-XIII COVID-19 rules and regulations

Access to the PMOD/WRC building will be restricted during IPC-XIII. Only persons who are <u>vaccinated</u>, have <u>recovered</u> from COVID-19, or present a <u>negative test</u> not older than 48 hours will be allowed to enter the building.



To get access to IPC-XIII you will have to choose from any of these three options:

- 1. If you are vaccinated, please present official proof of your vaccination on the first day of IPC-XIII. The proof can be a «COVID certificate», «COVID pass», or WHO vaccination certificate.
- 2. If you have recovered from a previous COVID-19 infection, you will have to present proof of your infection.
- 3. All staff, participants and visitors who are neither vaccinated nor recovered from a previous COVID-19 infection will have to test every 48 hours. Additional rules apply during IPC-XIII:

- 1. No shaking of hands
- 2. Wear a face mask at all times inside the building, if possible also outdoors
- 3. No sharing of food

The following general rules and recommendations apply within Switzerland:

- 1. Face masks are mandatory in public transports (trains, buses, etc.) and in buildings which are accessible by the public, including supermarket, shops, and restaurants except when sitting at the table.
- 2. Keep distance
- 3. Wash your hands frequently and use hand sanitizer where possible
- 4. Some events require a COVID certificate. These include sports events, clubs, festivals, IPC-XIII.
