Computing Per Diem when Crossing the International Date Line (IDL) and Traveling in a Westward Direction *without* a Lost Day (JTR, par. 020314)

Note: Rates used in these examples may not be current and are for illustrative purposes only.

Scenario:

The TDY location lodging cost is \$140 a night. The per diem rate is \$218 (\$146/\$72). The traveler departs (heading west) on August 18 and arrives at the TDY location on August 19. When crossing the IDL in a westward direction, the date August 19 is treated as a full day for per diem computation purposes as the traveler arrived on August 19. Upon return (west to east), when the traveler crosses the IDL, the traveler is paid M&IE for one day on August 25. Neither a Government dining facility nor a mess is available at the TDY point.
