Household Goods (HHG) Transportation Authorized When a Mobile Home is Also Transported (JTR, par. 052102)

The Government's total liability for the cost of moving a Service member's mobile home, shipping the unaccompanied baggage and other HHG is limited to the total Government-constructed cost to transport the Service member's maximum authorized permanent changes of station (PCS) HHG weight allowance between the old permanent duty station (PDS) and the new PDS.

Scenario: Due to a transfer from a PDS in the continental United States (CONUS) to a PDS in Germany, a Service member is authorized transportation of 12,000 pounds of HHG. The Service member transports a mobile home and 1,000 pounds of HHG from the old PDS to Cleveland, OH, and 4,000 pounds of HHG to the new PDS in Germany. The amount that the Government pays to transport the mobile home and the 1,000 pounds of HHG to Cleveland, and the 4,000 pounds of HHG to Germany may not exceed the Government's cost to transport the member's PCS HHG weight allowance of 12,000 pounds from the old PDS in the CONUS to the new PDS in Germany.
