

Dept. of Chemistry & Biochemistry Scholarship Descriptions

- The Richard Smith Freshman Scholarship provides scholarships to recruit freshmen majoring in chemistry. Requirements: demonstrated motivation, and academic and leadership potential; be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 2.0; be an incoming freshman and majoring in chemistry.
- The Gerald Swisher Scholarship provides scholarships annually to the most outstanding Chemistry majors at the University of Alaska Fairbanks starting his/her senior year. Requirements: demonstrated motivation, and academic and leadership potential; be in good academic standing with a minimum 3.5 GPA; be in his or her senior year the fall after nomination or application; be a Chemistry major.
- The Quinton Costello Memorial Scholarship provides scholarships to chemistry or biochemistry students of junior, senior or graduate standing. Requirements: class standing of junior, senior, or graduate student; demonstrated motivation, and academic and leadership potential; be in good academic standing with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, and 3.5 within their major; majoring in chemistry or biochemistry.
- The Ronald F. Cosgrave Engineering Scholarship provides scholarships to upper division engineering and chemistry students at the University of Alaska Fairbanks. The intent is to provide two equal scholarships, one per year to an engineering student and one to a chemistry student. Requirements: class standing of junior or senior; full-time attendance; majoring in Engineering or Chemistry at UAF.
- The ACS – Hach Scientific Scholarships provide two scholarships to chemistry students at UAF planning to become high school chemistry teachers. This scholarship can be renewed through the teaching credential program provided the students continue to meet award criteria and complete requirements of award. Requirements: must be chemistry major students who are U.S. citizens/permanent residents with minimum 3.0 GPA and are committed to becoming chemistry teachers. If recipient is a graduate student they must have a chemistry related undergraduate major. Continuing ACS-Hach Scientific Foundation Scholars may be approved to attend part-time on a case by case basis. Preference will be given to students with demonstrated financial need.
- The William S. Wilson Memorial Scholarship provides scholarships to students attending the University of Alaska who are studying science. Requirements: be a science major; demonstrate research interest and/or evidence of research potential i.e. research reports, publications etc.; a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0; be enrolled full-time. Preference will be given to undergraduate students.
