The Wilderness Institute has scholarship funds available for eligible students. YELLOWSTONE - NRSM374 This course is open to all students at University of Montana and is not a required course for any major. This value-added experience includes a multi-day, overnight experience that immerses students in the Yellowstone Ecosystem. The course fee covers personnel, equipment, accommodations, transportation, sustenance, and park user fees. Since this course is additive and meant to enhance learning opportunities, a course fee that covers all costs associated with the experience is warranted. The fee is being increased by a 5% inflationary factor in the second year. NRSM211 is a current fee in AY21/22 and AY22/23. The course was previously numbered NRSM210 but was changed in AY22/23.
