Canvas Tip Sheet

This checklist serves as a starting point for setting up your Canvas account and designing your course in Canvas.

Navigation and Settings

✓ Yes	Criteria	Notes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Account is personalized to reflect your own profile picture, desired account settings, and customized notification settings. ▣ Canvas Guides: ▣ How do I add a profile picture & How do I manage my Notification settings.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Course Navigation is clear and consistent (unused items are hidden from student view). ▣ How do I manage Course Navigation links?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Course Card image is added to provide a visual representation of the subject. ▣ How to I add an image to a course card?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Import is a tool used to bring in any previous course content or content shared to you by others. As relevant, use the Course Import tool to retrieve past content and activities. ▣ What is the Course Import Tool?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Course Grading Scheme is how Canvas translates percentages or points earned into a final grade. The Canvas default is enabled and should be checked or a new scheme added that matches the course syllabus. ▣ How do I view and manage grading schemes in a course?	

UM Canvas Template

✓ Yes	Criteria	Notes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Home Page is personalized by replacing the template information with your own. It is recommended that you use one of the UM Canvas Home Page templates. ▣ How do I change the Course Home Page?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Syllabus is available for download and follows the UM syllabus template. ▣ How do I edit the Syllabus in a course?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Getting Started Module is edited to reflect your specific instructor and course information. The Instructor Information page is edited to include a short video (recommended). The Introduction Forum is used for community building. All unused template items are deleted.	

Course Design

✓ Yes	Criteria	Notes
<input type="checkbox"/>	MUS Principles of Quality and Canvas Tools is consulted as a document to support quality course design and development.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Assignment Groups are created for weighted grade categories (if applicable). How do I add an assignment group in a course?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Develop Course Content by consulting the UM Canvas Essentials course and/or the Canvas Instructor Guides and Videos for instructions on adding content, activities, and assessments.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chunking of content allows students to engage with manageable pieces of information and activities. Leverage modules and pages (e.g. organized by units, chapters, topics, or weeks). What are Modules?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Check Alignment of your Syllabus to your course assignments and your gradebook to ensure that course outcomes are met and that the sequencing is logical and increases in understanding and difficulty.	

Course Finalization and Publishing

✓ Yes	Criteria	Notes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Accessibility is addressed by reviewing all content (videos are captioned, images are tagged, text clues such as headings and link names are used correctly). Use the Accessibility Checker to identify and correct accessibility issues within the course. How do I use the Accessibility Checker?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Link Validation is used to check that all links, files, videos, and external URLs are active and working. How do I validate links in a course?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Student and Mobile Views are tested to ensure accuracy and access from the student role. How do I view a course as a test student using Student View?	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Publishing your course should occur about one week prior to the start date. Publish and post a course announcement to welcome your students! If your course is published while you are designing the enrolled users will receive email notifications for each change and add (unless they have turned their notification settings off). How do I publish a course?
