This semester, UM is transitioning from Submittable to Interfolio for the Faculty Evaluation process. Due to Submittable's increased costs, UM has decided to transition to the Interfolio system as a more affordable and holistic approach to supporting faculty. Once fully implemented, Interfolio will support the faculty recruitment process, faculty evaluations, reviews, promotions, tenure, and sabbaticals, and even integrate research data from UM Impact into faculty dossiers. The full implementation of Interfolio will take some time, but the Office of the Provost is committed to communicating these exciting changes as we progress through this transition together.

Even though we are implementing a new system, you shouldn't notice a difference in the faculty evaluation process for the current semester. You will still be using the same forms and providing the information you always have, as outlined by your unit standards, just uploading them into a new system. If you have any questions about the faculty evaluation process and deadlines, we encourage you to review the CBA.
