Reducing Time to Science: Evolving Workflows for Geoscience Research and Education

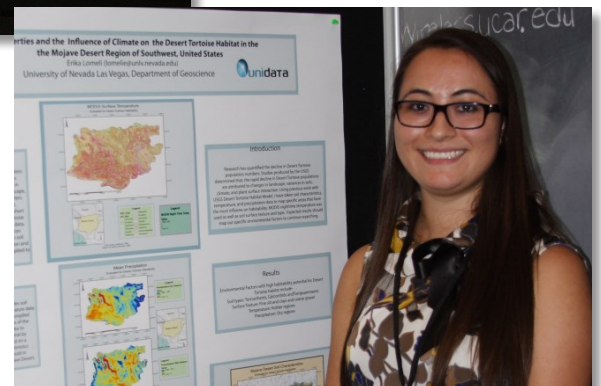
June 25-28, 2018 – Boulder, Colorado

The goal of this year's workshop is to raise awareness of the current trends in the academic geoscience community with an emphasis on Data Proximate Analysis, Machine Learning and Data Analytics, Using GOES-16 Data, and Working with Ensemble Numerical Weather Prediction Output. Scientists and educators from the academic geoscience community will present ideas and techniques for making effective use of geoscience data and share activities, course materials, and ideas for improving education and research.
