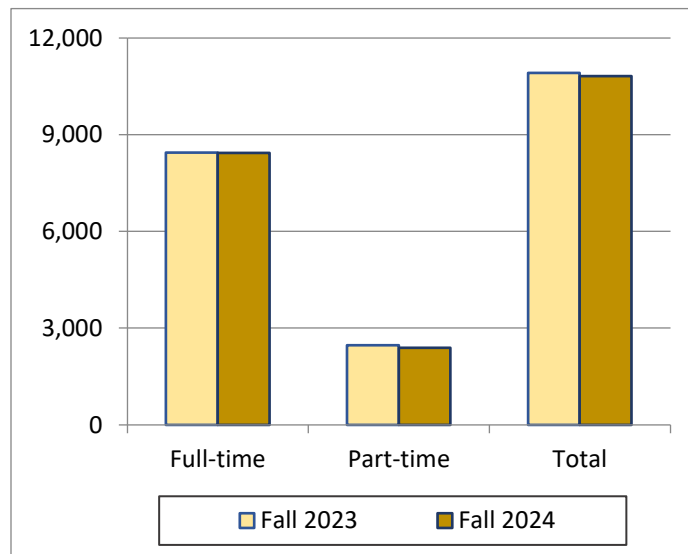

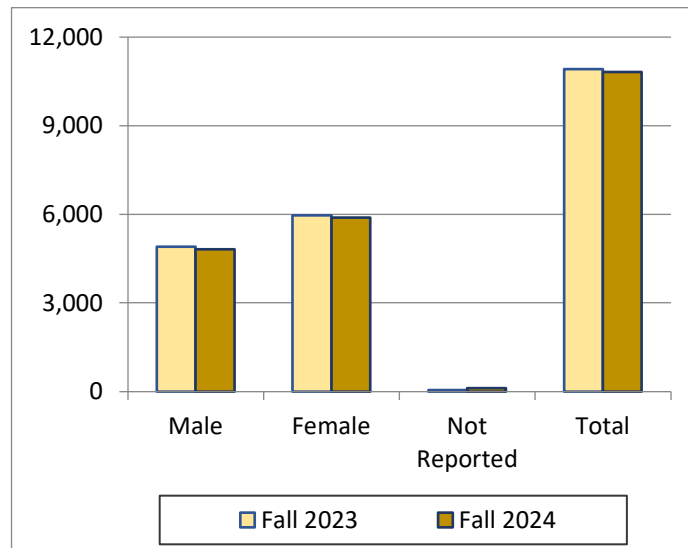

Examples: If a Laramie Campus student takes an online course, the hours are counted under Online/Distance. If a UW-Casper student takes a Laramie course, the hours are counted under Laramie. If a UW-Casper student takes an online course, the hours are counted under Online/Distance.
