

A BILL TO ELIMINATE THE POSITION OF PRESIDENT-ELECT.

6 University of Wyoming Staff Senate does not afford either continuity or training;

8 eliminated and instead the elected Vice-President will assume the office of
9 President in the subsequent year. All references to President-elect shall be
10 removed from the Rules of the Staff Senate and UNIREG34 and replaced with
11 Vice-President were appropriate.
