ADDENDUM A

Update to Staff Senate, Rules and Procedures Article V, Section 1.c

- c. Governance Committee
 - . Function
 - 1. The Committee shall conduct the elections of the Staff Senate and its officers and fill vacant seats, as outlined in these Rules and Procedures.
 - 2. The Committee shall provide a list of each division's constituents to the Senator(s) representing that division.
 - 3. The Committee shall keep oversight of the Rules and Procedures, evaluating areas that require improvement or clarification.
 - 4. Assist the Parliamentarian and Executive Committee regarding the interpretation of the Rules & Procedures when necessary.
 - ii. Powers
 - 1. The Committee shall ensure that candidates for Staff Senator have fulfilled the requirements as set forth in the Bylaws.
 - iii. Membership
 - 1. The Committee shall have a minimum of five (5) members, with one member elected by the Committee and approved by the President to serve as the chair.
 - 2. The Parliamentarian will sit as an ex-officio member of this committee
