VOTE 2024 LEGISLATIVE SCORECARD

This scorecard aims to help the community track legislators' voting records on key criminal justice, voting, and civil rights issues. Its goal is to enhance transparency and hold officials accountable for their actions, not just their words.

We assessed each legislator's voting history on 28 specific bills from the Louisiana 2024 Special Crime Session and General Legislative Session. Based on how their votes aligned with VOTE's positions, we assigned them an overall score. Below, you'll find a list of the 28 bills along with VOTE's stance on each.

BILLS ACROSS BOTH SENATE + HOUSE

- ACT 15 / HB 1 "TRANSPARENCY": Publicizes court records via a statewide online portal for people aged 17 and older. Excludes traffic violations but includes juveniles arrested for violent crimes (potentially sealed by court). Details include arrest, charging, bail decisions, hearings, judge, and prosecutor identities. No mechanism for deleting records if charges are dismissed. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the Senate 27-9. Passed the House 72-30. Absent: 3 Senators, 3 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 16 / HB 2 LIMIT LIABILITY FOR "PEACE OFFICERS": Limits liability of law enforcement unless criminal, fraudulent, or intentional misconduct. Includes shielding "gross negligence," likely affecting traffic accidents involving police officers. Police brutality claims still viable in federal court. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the Senate 26-11. Passed the House 73-31. Absent: 2 Senators, 1 House Rep. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 4 / HB 3 MANDATORY DRUG TESTING: Requires drug testing within 24 hours of arrests. Positive tests will be screened for substance abuse disorder and eligibility for Drug Court. Uses opioid settlement funds for drug testing, not Drug Court expenses (and likely violates drug settlement language). There is currently no lack of people eligible for drug courts. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the Senate 39-0. Passed the House 105-0. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 10 / HB 4 ENDS POST-CONVICTION DISCRETION: Removes discretion for judges and D.A.s to waive procedural roadblocks for 'out-of-time' or 'repetitive' applications (which is often the case to reverse wrongful convictions). No exceptions. Likely an unconstitutional erosion of judiciary power. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the Senate 28-11. Passed the House 73-31. Absent: 1 House Rep. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 17 / HB 5 "ILLEGAL USE OF WEAPON" REDEFINITION: Reclassifies "illegal use of weapon," such as firing a gun in the air, as a "violent" crime, even with nobody being hurt. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 85-19 Passed the Senate 28-11. Absent: 1 House Rep. Signed by the Governor.
 - ACT 18 / HB 7 STRICTER CARJACKING SENTENCES: Increases carjacking sentences to 20-30 years if involving serious bodily injury, and 5-20 years without; most cases currently charged under robbery statute. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 89-15 Passed the Senate 33-4. Absent: 1 House Rep, 2 Senators. Signed by the Governor.

- ACT 19 / HB 8 POSSESSION WITH INTENT OR DISTRIBUTION OF FENTANYL: Imposes severe penalties of 25-99 years for possession with intent or distribution of fentanyl with "reasonable appeal to a minor," regardless if a minor is present, and even if no sale occurred. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 92-13. Passed the Senate 37-0. Absent: 2 Senators. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 6 / HB 9 ENDS PAROLE: Eliminates parole for offenses committed after 8/1/24, except for Juvenile Life with Parole. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the Senate 28-11. Passed the House 71-33. Absent: 1 House Rep. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 7 / HB 10 SERVE AT LEAST 85%: Limits "good time" credits (sentence reductions for good behavior) to 15% max, with up to one year possible for program completions. No good time credits awarded while on parole. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 71-32. Passed the Senate 27-12. Absent: 2 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 8 / HB 11 PROBATION MAX: Extends max probation from 3 to 5 years, with the possibility of extension for unpaid fines/fees.

 Eliminates good time credits for probationers, imposes stricter penalties for technical violations, and allows violations for arrests alone. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 72-32, Passed the Senate 26-11.

 Absent: 1 House Rep, 2 Senators. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 259 / HB 173 POLICE BUBBLE: Creates 25-foot "get back" distance for police, including where families, bystanders, media, and medical professionals have no visual of the officer's activities. Currently faces litigation. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 81-20. Passed the Senate 27-12. Absent: 4 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 204 / HB 188 SCHOOL BOARD ELIGIBILITY: Permanently disqualifies school board candidates with most felony convictions, defying the constitution's current five-year waiting period post-sentence. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 93-6. Passed the Senate 38-0. Absent: 6 House Reps. 1 Senator. Signed by the Governor.
- HB 391 MARIJUANA POSSESSION PARDONS: This bill would streamline the pardon process for people convicted of marijuana possession. A "YES" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 59-41. Passed the Senate 31-7. Absent: 5 House Reps. 1 Senator. Vetoed By the Governor.
- ACT 436 / HB 608 ERASE TRANSGENDER IDENTITY: The law defines gender solely based on original birth certificates and requires separate facilities for each sex in sports, jails, juvenile centers, and shelters where safety and privacy are critical. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 80-17. Passed the Senate 29-10. Absent: 8 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 661 / HB 737 ANTI-PROTESTOR LAW: Prohibits a person from protesting within 50 feet of any residence if it interferes with their peace and quiet. (Complainant need not be the target of the protest). A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 85-18. Passed the Senate 26-11. Absent: 2 House Reps. 2 Senators. Signed by the Governor.

- ACT 1 / SB 1 CONCEALED CARRY: Allows adults over 18 (without felony convictions) to carry concealed firearms without a permit, except in certain places where it's prohibited by law. Property owners can also ban firearms on their premises. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 76-28. Passed the Senate 28-10. Absent: 1 House Rep, 1 Senator. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 2 / SB 2 GUN LIABILITY: Provides immunity from liability for firearm use in justified self-defense situations, except in cases of gross negligence, intentional misconduct, or felony convictions. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 74-30. Passed the Senate 27-11. Absent: 1 House Rep, 1 Senator. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 13 / SB 3 LOWER THE AGE: 17-year-olds are now charged as adults on all crimes, felony or misdemeanor. (Federal law still requires "sight and sound separation" between 17-year-olds and adults during incarceration). A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 74-26, Passed the Senate 30-9. Absent: 5 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 14 / SB 4 JUVENILE MANDATORY MINIMUM: Bars juveniles from seeking a sentence modification until 2 years have passed, or 50% if serving under 36 months. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 75-28; Passed the Senate 26-13. Absent: 2 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 11 / SB 5 UNANIMOUS PAROLE BOARD: Establishes unanimous parole board decisions, requires 3 years without major infractions for eligibility, extends prior notice to the public to 90 days, voids decisions if notification requirements aren't met, and establishes waiting periods for rehearing based on offense type. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 72-31. Passed the Senate 28-11. Absent: 2 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 22 / SB 8 RESTRUCTURE PUBLIC DEFENSE: Governor now appoints the statewide Public Defender and Executive Branch now has much more influence on the budgets and staffing of indigent defense. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 71-31 Passed the Senate 27-12. Absent: 3 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 246 / SB 276 CRIMINALIZING ABORTION-INDUCING DRUGS: Bypasses the federal and state drug "scheduling" process, and outlaws mifepristone and misoprostol. Creates the crime of coerced criminal abortion (giving an unsuspecting pregnant woman an abortion-inducing drug). A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 65-31; Passed the Senate 38-0. Absent: 9 House Reps. 1 Senator. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 651 / SB 371 SURGICAL CASTRATION: Provides surgical castration of persons convicted of certain sex crimes when the victim is under thirteen. Increase the barriers to residency for people convicted of sex crimes. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 74-24; Passed the Senate 29-9. Absent: 7 House Reps, 1 Senator. Signed by the Governor.

- ACT 670 / SB 388 IMMIGRANT PROFILING LAW: Creates the crime of unlawful entry or reentry into the state of Louisiana by an undocumented immigrant. Likely exceeding state jurisdiction into a federal matter. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 74-24; Passed the Senate 28-11. Absent: 7 House Reps. Signed by the Governor.
- ACT 500 / SB 436 PROOF-OF-CITIZENSHIP: Voter registration now requires proof of American citizenship, without explaining what is required. Likely a violation of the National Voter Registration Act. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House 68-26 Passed the Senate 28-10. Absent: 11 House Reps. 1 Senator. Signed by the Governor.

BILLS IN THE HOUSE ONLY

- HB 730 "THE FAIRNESS AND SAFETY FOR LOUISIANA INCARCERATED WORKERS ACT": Proposal included safety training, provision of protective equipment, and regular inspections of work environments by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and the creation of a Fair Wages Advisory Committee to establish fair wages for incarcerated workers, and increase of take-home pay in Work Release (currently less than a third). A "YES" vote supports VOTE position. The bill failed in the House 1-10, with 2 Reps. absent. Failed in Committee.
- HB 743 ABSENTEE JAIL VOTING: The bill would have allowed first-time incarcerated voters to cast absentee ballots, similar to provisions for military personnel, people with disabilities, and college students. State continues to deny ballot access for eligible voters. A "YES" vote supports VOTE position. The bill passed committee by a narrow 8-7 vote, marking a step towards expanding voting rights in Louisiana. The bill failed in the House 38-63, with 4 Reps absent. Failed on House floor.
- HB 800 CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION: Proposed convening a 4th Legislative Session, a Constitutional Convention at the end of the 2024 Regular Legislative Session to rewrite the state's Constitution. A "NO" vote supports VOTE position. Passed the House Floor 77-27, with 3 Reps absent. Referred to the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs. Failed in Committee.
