Waves reached residential structures along Eastlake Terrace in Rogers Park and a parking garage under one of these structures was flooded. Several cars were destroyed by the water. Two beaches in Rogers Park were permanently closed after significant beach erosion. Large sections of Loyola Beach were flooded including sidewalks and portions of the breakwall. Elliot Park near Evanston was flooded.
