A quick-moving system on Sunday night, March 12 into early Monday, March 13, brought widespread snow, then lake effect snow started Monday night and persisted through Tuesday, March 14. This lake effect snow was oriented into northeast Illinois for a lengthy period, which is rare as Michigan and northwest Indiana are typically the more favored locations for lake effect snow.

The first round of snow caused impacts to the Monday morning commute, while the next lake effect round brought major impacts to the Tuesday morning commute.

Some of the highest snowfall totals in Lake County include 10.5 inches in Munster and 10.0 inches in Dyer.
