Lake Shore Drive was closed for several miles on the north side of Chicago due to flash flooding including multiple vehicles stuck in flood waters. Multiple viaducts were also flooded with stranded vehicles including at Lake Shore Drive and Foster and Lake Shore Drive and Fullerton. Widespread street flooding was reported in many areas with four feet of water at the intersection of Fullerton and Elston. Two to three feet of flood water was reported in roadways in Elmwood Park including 74th Avenue, 74th Court, Altgeld Street and near Diversey and Harlem. Flood waters one feet deep were reported on the shoulder of Interstate 90/94.
