Pay and windy conditions created dangerous fire conditions on October 14th. A large wildfire started in a field about 6 miles west of barnforth during the afternoon of October 14th. The fire quickly spread with strong southerly winds gusting to 50 mph along with valuable hundridly lovels as low as 20 percent. Multipple fire departments responded and it wans't until firemer arrived to start making ine breaks that the fire was brought under control and eventually put out, over 5 hours after it started. The cause of the fire was not movern. No damage for structure was reported though approximately 40 acres of grain was lost.
