Very cold air spread across northern Illinois in early January with high temperatures in the teens and low temperatures in the single digits. The coldest low temperature was 1 degree below zero at O'Hare Airport, which was measured on the morning of January 3rd. An 87 year old female died on Prater Street in Northlake on January 2nd due to an unheated home. An 80 year old woman died on Tabler Road in Minooka after she began walking after her car got stuck on railroad tracks. A 72 year old man died on 68th Street in Chicago on January 4th due to cold exposure. A 63 year old man died on Woodlawn Street in Chicago due to cold exposure.

A winter storm moved across northern Illinois on January 7th. Snow began falling late in the evening on January 6th and continued into the morning hours of January 8th. Storm total snowfall amounts included 8.3 inches 2 miles north of Spring Grove; 8.2 inches in Grayslake; 8.0 inches 3 miles southwest of Barrington; 8.0 inches 3 miles southeast of Streator; 8.0 inches in Wauconda; 8.0 inches in Winfield; 7.8 inches at the National Weather Service in Romeoville; 7.7 inches in Elgin; 7.7 inches in Streamwood; 7.6 inches in La Grange; 7.6 inches 2 miles southwest of Oak Brook; 7.5 inches at O'Hare Airport; 7.4 inches in Lake Zurich; 7.4 inches 4 miles west southwest of Mundelein; 7.0 inches in Belvidere; 6.7 inches 2 miles southwest of Genoa; 6.5 inches in Elburn; 6.5 inches in Marengo and 6.0 inches 5 miles northwest of Milford.

A winter storm moved across northwest Indiana on January 7th and 8th. Snow began falling late in the evening on January 6th and continued into the morning hours of January 8th. Lake effect snow then began falling on January 8th and continued through the evening of January 9th. Storm total snowfall amounts included 11.9 inches in Schererville; 9.7 inches in Highland; 9.1 inches in Lowell; 6.5 inches 2 miles south of Morocco; 6.4 inches 2 miles west northwest of Wanatah and 5.9 inches in Rensselaer.
