Periods of moderate to heavy snow across northeastern Illinois dropped 6 to 7 inches of snow in some areas. The heaviest snow reports include: 7.0 inches near New Lenox; 6.5 inches near Burnham-Hegewisch; and 6.2 inches southwest of Plainfield (in Kendall County).

### INDIANA, Northwest

A low pressure system brought a few inches of snow to the region but a lake effect snow band focused over portions of Porter County resulting in a swath of 6 to 9 inches of snow. Some of the highest snow reports include: 8.7 inches near Porter; 8.4 inches near Portage; and 6.4 inches near Lakes of the Four Seasons.
