

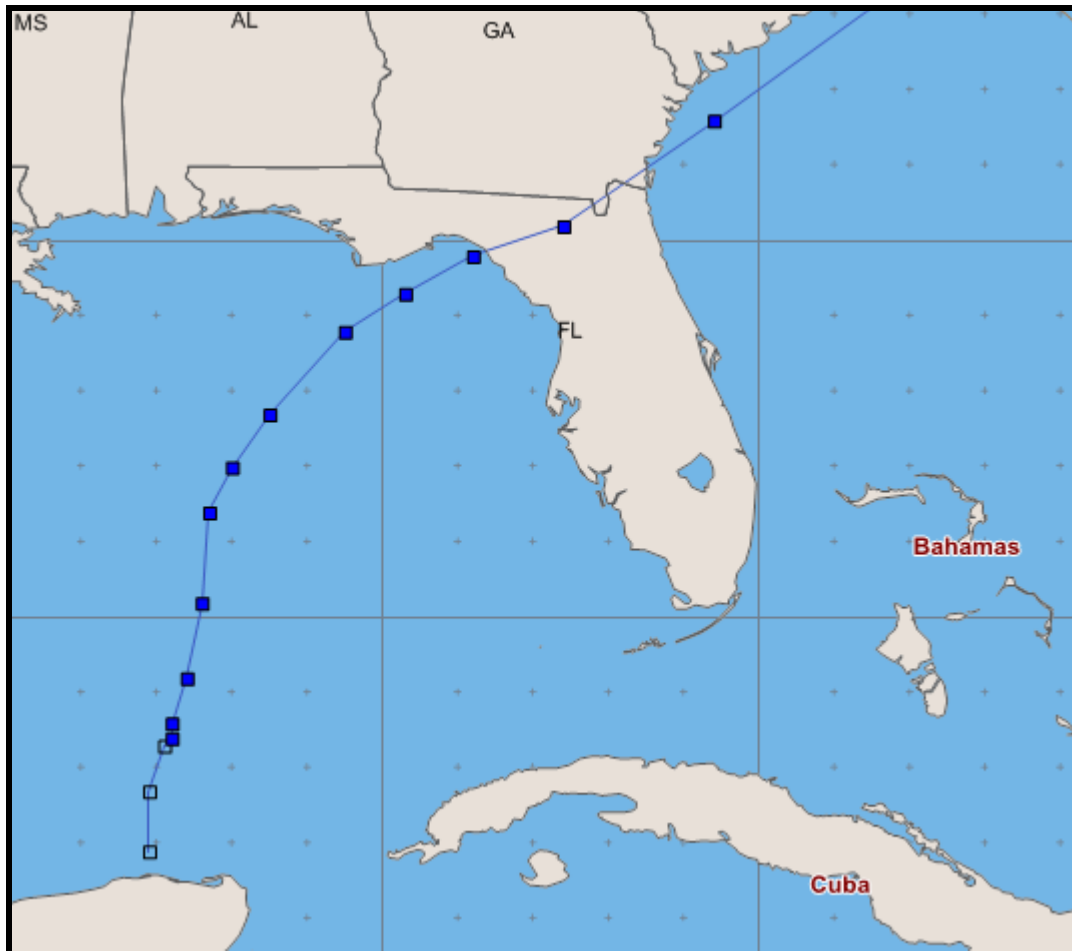

Overview:

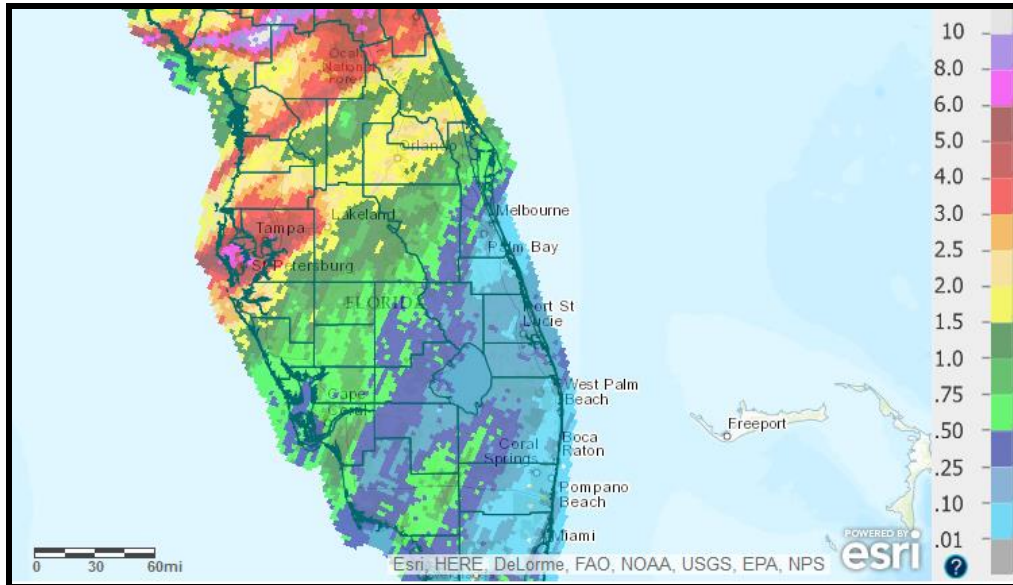
Tropical Depression #3 formed in the southern Gulf of Mexico on the morning of Sunday June 5, 2016. The depression strengthened into Tropical Storm Colin late that afternoon. Colin moved across the northeastern Gulf of Mexico Monday and onshore the Florida Big Bend region late evening on Monday June 6. The center of Colin moved offshore the Georgia coast in the pre-dawn hours of Tuesday June 7.

Rainfall in East Central Florida:

The highest rainfall amounts associated with Colin were across the northern sections of East Central Florida. The highest rainfall totals for the 24 hour period ending at 12 UTC Tuesday were between 3-5" (table below).

Highest Winds:

The highest winds were in squalls associated with Colin. The highest gust recorded in East Central Florida was at USAF wind tower KSC-1007, east of the Titusville TICO Airport with a gust from the SW to 66 mph (57 knots).
