


Winter Weather Advisory Continues

Key Messages

- → A High Wind Warning for portions of northeast NE & a Wind Advisory for portions of eastern NE & western IA will go into effect from 9 AM through 6 PM today.
 - High Wind Warning: Winds at 30 to 40 mph, gusts up to 60 mph
 - Wind Advisory: Winds at 25 to 35 mph, gusts up to 50 mph
- → Winds will begin out of the southwest and gradually shift clockwise to northwesterly
- → Strong winds & low relative humidity will lead to elevated fire weather concerns today.


Overall Forecast Confidence








Maximum Wind Gust & Minimum Relative Humidity



→ Winds will begin out of the southwest and gradually shift clockwise to northwesterly




→ Low relative humidity values will bring enhanced fire weather concerns today.
