1 What is a StormReady® Supporter?

A Supporter is an organization, business, facility or local government entity actively engaged in weather safety and preparedness that is unable to meet all the requirements of the full StormReady program.

StormReady helps community leaders and emergency managers strengthen local safety programs.

No community is storm proof, but StormReady can help communities save lives.

3 Becoming a StormReady® Supporter

Contact NWS Springfield to discuss the application and approval process. Next, you will need to complete the application form (link below). A verification visit will be arranged with the NWS Springfield office to review your hazardous weather plan and ensure you meet StormReady Supporter Guidelines. Upon completion of these steps and final approval, you will receive StormReady Supporter recognition.

StormReady® Supporter Guidelines

- Warning Reception
- Communication/Relay of Warning
- Hazardous Weather Response Plan
- Sheltering Location
- Preparedness (Drills, Exercises, and/or Training)

(These are recommended minimal requirements to achieve the StormReady “Supporter” designation)
