**New Provider Orientation:** YWCA Metropolitan Chicago offers an orientation workshop for anyone interested in becoming a small business entrepreneur called **Quality Beginnings**. Information and resources will be provided on opening and operating a child care business. This workshop is intended for **new child care business owners that have been in business 1 year or less**.

**CCAP Training Requirements - CPR/First Aid:** The Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) partners with child care providers to serve low income families through the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP). To help ensure the health and safety of children, the Federal government is now requiring that providers complete specific health, safety and child development training, have current CPR/First Aid certification, and complete annual training hours.

**CCDBG Health, Safety, & Child Development Requirements:** The Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act made major changes designed to protect the health and safety of children in early care and education (ECE) settings. One of the mandated changes included in the Act was, States and Territories must have minimum health and safety training to be completed pre-service or during an orientation period in addition to ongoing training. Providers can take any course in the Gateways Registry in order to meet annual/ongoing training requirements. No specific set of courses is mandated in order to meet annual/ongoing training requirements.

**Program for Infant-Toddler Care:** Comprised of four modules, the Program for Infant Toddler Care (PITC) is designed to help child care directors and infant/toddler care teachers become sensitive to infants' cues, connect with their family and culture, and develop responsive, relationship-based care. This training takes an in-depth look at cognitive and social-emotional development, encouraging growth within daily routines and tips on setting up appropriate environments for experienced infant and toddler professionals.  
**Participants must complete all 4 modules and assessment to receive credit for all modules.**

**Specialized Trainings:** Trainings covering multiple content areas related to the field of early childhood education.

**Requisitos de capacitación de CCAP - RCP/primeros auxilios:** El Departamento de Servicios Humanos de Illinois (IDHS) colabora con proveedores de cuidado de niños para servir a familias de bajos ingresos a través del Programa Asistencia Para Cuidado de Niños (CCAP). Para ayudar a asegurar la salud y la seguridad de los niños, el Gobierno federal ahora requiere que los proveedores completen entrenamiento específico de salud, seguridad y desarrollo del niño, cuenten con la certificación de RCP/Primeros Auxilios, y completen las horas anuales requeridas de entrenamiento.

**Entrenamientos especializados:** Capacitaciones que cubren múltiples áreas de contenido relacionadas con el campo de la educación infantil.

**Redleaf Family Child Care Curriculum: Teaching Through Quality Care (DuPage County)****Presenter: Lina Rinko**

This training will use knowledge from the domains of child development: physical, cognitive, communication and language, social and emotional, and approaches to learning to establish policies, practices, routines, and a safe environment for children in family child care. Distinguish between typical and atypical development patterns in all domains. Translate developmental knowledge into daily actions and interactions with children and families that support child development in all domains. Plan and provide activities to support children's development in all domains, from birth to kindergarten age. Implement high-quality, positive learning experiences for all children in all domains of development. Use knowledge of child development to access supports, as needed, and successfully include children with special needs in a family child care setting. Modify the environment, policies, practices and routines to ensure that children's growth and development are supported. Produce an action plan for curriculum implementation in individual family child care programs. Practice recording observations and formal assessments with Redleaf's Family Child Care Curriculum Development Assessment Tool. Use concepts from The Redleaf Family Child Care Curriculum book to create high-quality, individualized lesson plans.

### Program for Infant Toddler Care (PITC) Module 1: Social Emotional Growth and Socialization (Virtual)

**Presenter: Casey Craft-Cortes**

Social-Emotional Growth and Socialization explores topics on social-emotional development in the first three years, temperaments of children and caregivers, socialization, guidance and discipline, environments, and gaining an understanding of children's behavior. Training will begin with an overview of the basic concepts of early social-emotional growth and socialization and their application to the group care context. An emphasis is placed on the development of a nurturing relationship between the infant and caregiver. The overview addresses the importance of responsive caregiving, the individualization of care through an understanding of infant temperament, the critical role of family and culture in early identity development, exploring developmentally appropriate play strategies with ages of infancy, creating supportive physical environments, and stages of emotional development.

Group Care introduces special considerations in caring for infants and toddlers and six program policies that support the development of emotionally secure relationships and mental health in the group care setting. An overview of the content of Module 2 explores the ideas of primary care, well-designed learning environments, positive impact of responsive caregiving routines, and individualized care on the well-being and development of children from birth to three. Attention is also given to how the policies of primary care, small groups, continuity of care, culturally responsive care, and inclusive care of children with special needs prove the foundation for high quality infant/toddler care. At the end of this module, participants will have the tools to use primary care in their home or classroom, make engaging environments, assist children in daily routines, and individualize care for all children.
